

29. The Marie Watson-Blake Award for Outstanding Contribution by an Individual

This award recognises the extraordinary personal and professional achievement and contribution by an individual over many years to the Australian, and particularly the Queensland tourism industry.

Important Notes:

- No Accreditation or pre-assessment is required for this category
- No site visit or interview required
- The award will not be made to the same person twice
- Nominations are acceptable from any party except the nominee
- The word limit for this submission is 2500 words (not including CV, letters of recommendation, etc)
- The nominee's Curriculum Vitae and no more than 5 letters of recommendation may be include
- This award will be presented at the discretion of the judges, based on the submissions received
- This category is awarded in Queensland only

Submission

Question 1. Overview of the nominee (10 marks)

Question 2. Nominee's professional contribution and service (20 marks)

Question 3. Nominee's personal contribution and service (20 marks)
