

Gold sweep for Queensland at Australian Tourism Awards

- The nation's best of the best in the tourism industry gathered on Friday 17 March in Sydney for the 2022 Qantas Australian Tourism Awards.
- The Qantas Australian Tourism Awards are the biggest annual celebration of tourism business excellence in Australia.
- Out of the 25 award categories, Queensland businesses have taken out seven gold, three silver, and six bronze.
- Having won gold on a state level at the 2022 Queensland Tourism Awards, Queensland's 25 finalists competed for the top gong at the national awards.

Queensland businesses have won big at the Qantas Australian Tourism Awards in Sydney, taking out gold, silver or bronze in 16 of the 25 categories.

Overall, Queensland celebrated a remarkable night by accepting 16 accolades at this year's national awards with seven gold, three silver, and six bronze being awarded to exceptional sunshine state operators.

A total of 75 awards were presented across 25 categories with a gold, silver and bronze winner announced for each category. The awards were supported by major sponsor, Qantas, with Tourism Australia and Destination NSW supporting sponsors.

Wildcat Mackay was crowned best new tourism business while the Sunshine Coast's Bli Bli House was named best hosted accommodation.

Brisbane's Fun Over 50 Holidays took out the top gong for tour and transport operator with Cape York Peninsula Lodge crowned the best 4-4.5 star deluxe accommodation in Australia.

The acclaimed BIG4 Adventure Whitsunday Resort was awarded gold for caravan and holiday parks.

The highly coveted tourist attraction award was presented to Queensland icon, Bundaberg Rum Distillery Visitor Experience while Outback Queensland Masters took the title for best festivals and events.

Nine other Queensland tourism operators from the Gold Coast to the Tropical North took to the podium with silver or bronze, including Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary who were crowned Australia's third best major tourist attraction.
